

## **Frequently Asked Question (FAQ)**

**Q.1. When should I report to the institute?**

Ans: Physical reporting date in Institute is between 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 to 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021 (Subject to Govt. Guidelines). The commencement of Physical classes in Institute will start on 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

**Q.2. Conveyance?**

Ans: Local Bus service, Taxi.

**Q.3. ATM facility?**

Ans: Nearest ATM of PNB bank is approx.2KM from Institute.

**Q.4. How much fee needs to be paid for 1<sup>st</sup> semester at the time of reporting at Institute?**

Ans: The total fee of 1<sup>st</sup> semester is Rs.67,700/- ( excluding Rs.2000/- counseling fee )

- Students admitted through JEE ( Joint Entrance Exam ):-
  - i. Rs. 40,000/- to be paid at the time of online counseling which includes Rs.2000/- counseling fee paid through online mode on NCHMCT portal.
  - ii. Rs. 17,000/- is to be paid at the time of reporting in Institute which can be paid through ATM (Debit /Credit Card), UPI or by Demand Draft of Nationalized Bank in favour of **Principal, Institute of Hotel Management, Hamirpur (HP)** payable at Hamirpur (H.P).
  - iii. Rs.12,700/- is to paid as IGNOU registration fee through online mode on IGNOU's portal by student concern.
- Students admitted against Residual Seats:-
  - i. Rs. 55,000/- is to be paid at the time of reporting in Institute which can be paid through ATM (Debit /Credit Card), UPI or by Demand Draft of Nationalized Bank in favour of **Principal, Institute of Hotel Management, Hamirpur (HP)** payable at Hamirpur (H.P).
  - ii. Rs.12,700/- is to paid as IGNOU registration fee through online mode on IGNOU's portal by student concern.

**Q.5. What documents are required to be brought by the candidate at the time of his physical reporting in the Institute:-**

*Ans: The following documents are required to be submitted:-*

- a) Provisional Admission letter issued by NCHMCT in original
- b) Matriculation Certificate OR Certificate of equivalent qualification
- c) 10+2 Qualification Certificate
- d) Character certificate **in Original.**
- e) School Leaving / Migration Certificate **in Original.**
- f) Medical Certificate **in Original.**
- g) 4 Passport Size photographs. ( in white shirt only )
- h) Anti-ragging affidavit by the candidate\*
- i) Anti-ragging affidavit by the parents/guardian\*
- j) A set of photocopies of above documents

## **About Hostel**

**Q.1. What is the procedure for hostel allotment?**

Ans: Students will apply for hostel seat at the time of their Physical Reporting in the institute between 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 to 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021 (Subject to Govt. Guidelines). Final list of allotment of hostel will be declared by Institute on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 (Subject to Govt. approval). Mess facility for hostel students will start from the dinner of 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 (Subject to Govt. Guidelines).

**Q.2. What are the Hostel charges?**

Ans: Rs 60,000/- for academic session 2021-22 (inclusive of 5000/- refundable security deposit).

**Q.3. Whether hostel charges are to be deposited by Cash or Demand Draft.**

Ans: You need to pay the hostel fee through ATM (Debit /Credit Card) or by Demand Draft of Nationalized Bank in favour of **Principal, Institute of Hotel Management, Hamirpur (HP)** payable at Hamirpur (H.P)

**Q.4. Being Hosteller what items should I bring with me?**

Ans: The Institute will provide you a bed (without mattress), almirah and study table with chair. Rest all you require to bring as per your individual needs.

**Q.5. Whether bedding is also to be brought or Institute will provide?**

Ans: You need to bring your own bedding.

**Q.6. Whether we can shift our luggage/ beddings in hostel before 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2021? Or when we can shift in hostel?**

Ans: If allotted one may shift immediately after depositing the fee of Rs.60,000/-. However, food will be provided only from the Dinner of 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.

**Q.7. How many students share a room?**

Ans: 2 students are housed in one Room.
